Frost Delay Policy for Oakwood and Ironwood Golf Courses

The following procedures shall be followed in the event of a frost delay.

Shot gun starts:

30 minute up to 1 hour delay

The shotgun start will take place and the afternoon shotgun will be set to start at a time that allows the morning group to complete their round. This could leave a delayed start up to an hour for the afternoon group.

$1 \frac{1}{2}$ – 2 hour delay

The shotgun start will take place but the morning group shall play only 9 holes. The afternoon shotgun shall start at the normal time.

Tee Time starts:

Tee times will begin with the first scheduled tee time up to an hour delay.

In the event that the delay is longer than one hour, play will start with the *tee time scheduled at the time that the delay is lifted. All prior tee times shall be forfeited.

*Example: First tee time was at 8am. One hour delay will begin with the scheduled 9am starting time.

As we enter our winter months, frost delays will happen from time to time. Our employees will do their best to inform you about course conditions and length of delays. We appreciate your patience and cooperation during the delays and hope that you understand the reason why we do not allow play when there is frost on the course. While there is no one perfect solution for frost delays we ask that when you make your tee time that you take into consideration the chance of frost during the early stages of the morning.
