


YESTERDAY

The Sun Lakes active adult community began in 1972 with 2,560 acres of farmland, spearheaded by real estate developer Ed Robson. The partnership initially sold lots and mobile homes in order to compete with Sun City in the west valley. Robson survived the energy crisis of the 1970s and bought out his partners. In 1976, Mr. Robson began offering single family homesites in Sun Lakes.

TODAY

Now sold out, Sun Lakes is comprised of approximately 10,000 established homes, a softball field, five golf courses, the first-of-its-kind Jason Morton Tennis Center, eight newly designed pickleball courts, five country clubs, two shopping centers, and medical and education centers.





IronOaks, an age-restricted 55+ gated community, features 730 homes in Ironwood and 3,289 in Oakwood. Villas, single, and two-story homes range in size from 1,300 to 4,000 square feet with interior, lakeside, golf course, or walking path views.

The Villas are a sub-section of IronOaks and are all single-level, duplex-style residences. Villa homeowners have their own separate HOA dues which covers the exterior of homes, including roof repair, driveways, and exterior paint, as well as landscaping. A separate Board of Directors governs the 327 homes.

OAKWOOD

Known for its three distinct Keith Foster designsone parkland, one traditional links, and one navigating links, the three nine-hole Oakwood courses are a favorite for those who love this classic game. Sonoran-Lakes plays 4,966 - 6,577 yards, with nine holes circling around water features. Lakes-Palms is a challenging yet enjoyable course that plays 5,343 - 6,508 yards on a water-intensive path, ending near our premiere Oakwood Golf Shop. Palms-Sonoran plays through lush parkland and water features before finishing on a more traditional links-style course. It plays 5,138 yards at the forward tees to 6,567 yards at the tournament tees.

IRONWOOD

The newly-renovated Ironwood course plays from just under 4,000 yards at the forward tees to just over 5,100 at the championship tees. The course winds through lush grounds with two water features, and the two par-5s, seven par-3s, and nine par-4s make for a fast, yet rewarding, round of golf for players of all skill levels.
